

WALLA WALLA, WHERE FAMILIES HAVE FUN!



A flexible, family-friendly itinerary for a fun day in the Walla Walla Valley. Most stops do not require reservations and are open daily.

8:00 AM Kick off the day with breakfast at <u>Clarette's</u>. A Walla Walla staple with that classic diner vibe it is located downtown, near the beautiful Whitman College campus. Early risers will be delighted knowing this spot is open at 6 AM daily.

9:00 AM Get the wiggles out, with a visit to the crown jewel park of Walla Walla, <u>Pioneer Park</u>, which was designed by famous NYC Central Park architect Frederick Olmstead, to receive President Taft for a 5-hour visit to the city. Enjoy broad shady canopies from world record-holding oaks while you peruse the vibrant community-run aviary. The park also features an expansive playground, pickleball courts and ping pong!

11:00 AM Now that everyone has had time to explore and play in Pioneer Park, it is time to head west on Old Highway 12 to <u>Woodward Canyon Winery</u>. Established in 1981 as the second Walla Walla winery - you can enjoy their wines daily with no reservations required. There is plenty of space to play lawn games in their beautiful garden tasting room.

12:00 PM Older kids may enjoy the history of the <u>Whitman Mission</u>, an early outpost for Oregon Trail settlers in the Walla Walley, and the site of the infamous Whitman Massacre.

Younger kids might be better suited to enjoy a visit to <u>Frog Hollow Farms</u> (closed Saturdays). Offering more local seasonal produce and much more, this stop has animals you can feed and a gated play area. If you're here before frost rolls in, enjoy over 70 different varieties of tomatoes!

1:00 PM You can make your own picnic from the selection at Frog Hollow or enjoy the winner of Walla Walla's 'tastiest taco'. <u>Happy Wanderer</u> is a Mexican restaurant located in College Place, WA, this stop is very close to the Southside Wine District and offers fresh, handmade tortillas and salsas. Vegans & vegetarians will rejoice at the offerings as well.



2:00 PM In the heart of the Southside Wine District is <u>Canvasback</u>. Make reservations to enjoy the comparative tasting experience highlighting the differences between regional growing sites -- Red Mountain, Walla Walla and the Rocks District of Milton-Freewater. Keep the kids busy with cornhole or classic board games. The whole family can watch the hawks coasting along the nearby Walla Walla River. *Reservations are recommended.*

3:00 PM Head downtown to enjoy <u>Echolands Winery</u>. Our tasting room is the perfect place to kick back after a day of family fun. Dedicated to using only Walla Walla Valley fruit and offering several single-varietal, single-vineyard wines, like the 2022 Riviere-Galets Grenache, join us for an afternoon tasting.

4:00 PM Within walking distance of Echolands tasting room, you can enjoy bowling and the arcade at Stardust Lanes.

5:30 PM Kids of all ages will enjoy a chance to ride the mechanical bull at <u>T-Post Tavern</u> (closed Monday & Tuesday). This brand new, but old school country bar is family friendly 4 - 10 PM, featuring live music and dancing after 9 PM Thursday - Saturday. Enjoy their smoked meats and kids menu.



Keep the thrills going after dark at the <u>Walla Walla Corn Maze</u> - offering "scary hours" after dark all through October. Hours vary by day.
